INTEGRATING DCF LAB INPUTS INTO A STATE TRANSFORMATION PROGRAM: WATER SECTOR

DCF conducted a multi-stakeholder, consensus based planning program titled Water for All by 2019 Lab that spanned a period of six weeks. It had the ambitious objective of making the State of Maharashtra drought-free by 2019. Through extensive research and analysis, combined with multi-disciplinary knowledge and best practices, DCF identified 32 high impact initiatives which would be transformative in nature.

MULTI-STAKEHOLDER CONSENSUS BASED PLANNING PROCESS



IMPACT OF WATER FOR ALL BY 2019 LAB

- 70+ • Participants in the water lab
- 60+ • Organizations including relevant government agencies, NGOs, corporates specializing in water and even international organizations
- 30+ • Syndication meetings held with subject matter experts, including senior government officials, corporates, international organizations and water activists
- 8000+ • Man-years of experience in the water lab
- 240+ • Hours of lab effort logged by the Water Lab team, with more to come
- 200000 • Man-hours of effort logged by the Water Lab team
- 9 • Water source and conservation initiatives
- 10 • Agricultural initiatives
- 13 • Domestic and industry initiatives
- 32 • Government of Maharashtra included 14 of the 32 initiatives identified into their flagship project called the 'Jalyukta Shivar Abhiyan' or 'Water Secure Region'
- Initiatives from Water Lab under PPP worth \$12 Billion were identified
- Government of Maharashtra nominated DCF as 'Evaluation and Monitoring Agency' for Jalyukta Shivar Abhiyan

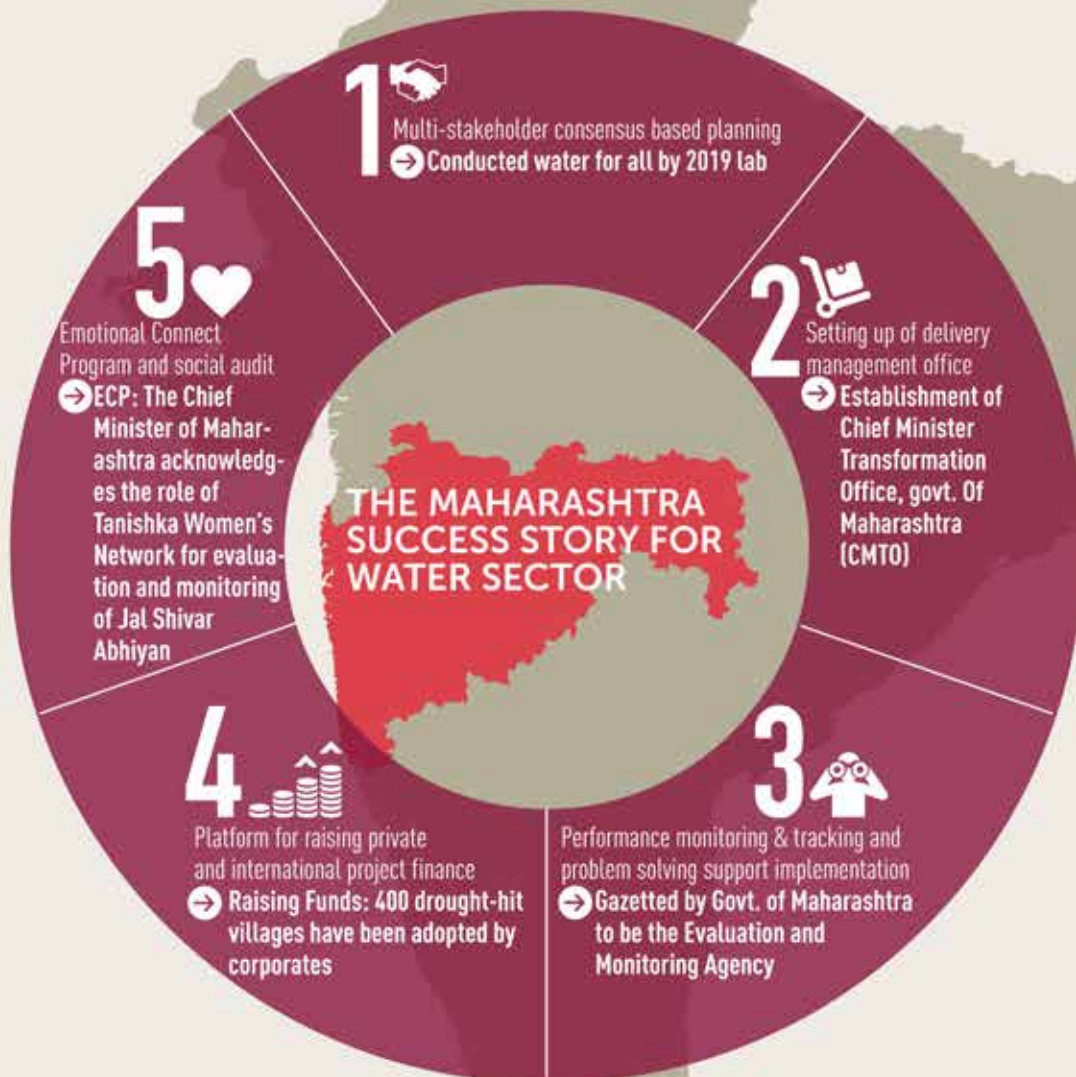
